Cybersecurity Awareness

Don't take the bait! Learn to identify and avoid phishing attacks that steal your personal information and compromise your security.

Check the Sender



Verify email addresses carefully. Look for misspellings, unusual domains, or addresses that don't match the claimed sender.

Hover Before You Click



Hover over links to preview URLs. Be suspicious of shortened links or addresses that don't match the expected destination.

Beware of Urgency



Phishing emails often create false urgency. Take time to verify suspicious requests, especially those demanding immediate action.

Never Share Credentials



Legitimate companies will never ask for passwords, SSN, or financial information via email. When in doubt, contact them directly.
